That the following provisions shall apply to the Wales Bill for the purpose of supplementing the Orders of 14 June 2016 (Wales Bill (Programme)) and 12 September 2016 (Wales Bill (Programme) (No. 2)):

Consideration of Lords Amendments

1. Proceedings on consideration of Lords Amendments shall (so far as not previously concluded) be brought to a conclusion three hours after their commencement at today's sitting.
