1 Amendment of Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001

In section 1 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (c. 16) (offences leading to penalties on the spot) insert —

"(1A) The entry in the Table in subsection (1) relating to section 1 of the Theft Act 1968 does not apply to theft from retail and commercial premises."

2 Short title and extent

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Theft from Shops (Penalties) Act.
- (2) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
